On behalf of Governor Brian P. Kemp, it is my pleasure to inform you that a Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP) award has been approved by the Federal Emergency Management Agency. This grant, which has been designated HMGP 4579-0006-F, will be used to purchase and distribute five hundred (500) portable weather radios throughout Carroll County. The total approved cost is \$15,450.00 with a federal share of \$13,905.00, a state share of \$618.00, and local share \$927.00.
