The Board of Commissioners met in a called session on Monday, June 28, 2010, at 4:00 p.m. in the Commission Chambers of the David Perry County Administration Building, 423 College Street, Carrollton, Georgia.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Chappell.

Budgets

The Commission considered a proposed Resolution and Ordinance Providing for the Appropriations and Expenditures of Funds for the Government of Carroll County, Georgia, for the County Fiscal Year 2011, Beginning July 1, 2010, and Ending June 30, 2011; Providing for the Operations of County Departments, Boards, Agencies, Elected Offices, and Other Governmental Activities; To Provide for the Level of Personnel Authorized for the Various Departments and Agencies; To Provide for Capital Improvements as Budgeted for the County; To Provide an Effective Date; and for Other Purposes.

**Commissioner Wilson made a motion to APPROVE the Resolution and Budgets as presented. Commissioner Chambers seconded the motion. Commissioner Jackson then made a motion to AMEND Commissioner Wilson's motion to include the following changes to the General Fund Budget: #5456-NAACP cut \$5,000 and move to Contingency; #7130-Ag Resources cut \$29,827.20 and move to Contingency; #3800-E911 cut \$70,862 and reduce E911 Revenues by the same amount; #3910-Animal Control cut \$8,000 and move to Contingency; and**

**#6221-Parks add \$5,000 for the Carroll County Veterans Memorial Park from the aforementioned funds moved into Contingency. Commissioner Anderson made a motion to adjourn – the motion failed due to the lack of a second. Chairman Chappell then made a call for the question. The Commission voted 2-5 (Chappell, North, Hendrix, Wilson & Chambers opposed) to approve Commissioner Jackson’s motion to amend the proposed budget. The Commission then voted 4-3 (Anderson, Hendrix & Jackson opposed) to APPROVE Commissioner Wilson’s motion to approve the proposed resolution and budgets as presented.**

Adjournment

**There being no further business to come before the Commission, Commissioner Wilson made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 6:26 p.m., the motion seconded by Commissioner Jackson was approved by a vote of 7-0.**
