Fairfield POA Emergency Assistance Agreement **On a motion by Commissioner Anderson and seconded by Commissioner Hendrix, the Commission voted 7-0 to approve an Agreement Between Carroll County, Georgia and the Fairfield Plantation Property Owners' Association (POA) For The Provision Of Emergency Roadway Repair Materials. The Agreement is in response to the severe flooding on September 21, 2009 which resulted in major damage to the roadways within Fairfield Plantation Community that has impeded the delivery of emergency services (i.e. fire trucks and ambulances) to this community and thereby endangering the health, safety and welfare of its citizens.**
