

MEDICAL SERVICES FOR JUVENILE DETAINEES

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The Carroll County Board of Commissioners submits Addendum 1 to Solicitation No. 10-A003, **MEDICAL SERVICES FOR JUVENILE DETAINEES**. These services will be performed prior to the placement into the Regional Youth Detention Center (RYDC) in Paulding County. In an effort to clarify Specifications, Conditions and Terms the following changes or additions are made to the original Request for Proposal (RFP).

I. GENERAL CHANGES TO ORIGINAL SOLICITATION

1. The following is clarification for the services listed in Paragraph II (Project Specifications).
 - Juvenile Clearance: The Contractor will make a determination/recommendation on the general health and well-being of the juvenile in regards to incarceration.
 - Conduct a medical interview, with the juvenile, to determine general health and condition of the individual.
 - Perform basic first aid, if required.
 - Take vital signs (Blood Pressure, Temperature, Respiration and Pulse)
 - Urine Pregnancy Test: To be conducted on females who, as the result of the medical interview, appear to be late with their menstrual cycle.
 - Juvenile Drug and Alcohol Screen: To be conducted only at the request of the arresting officer. A ten-panel drug and alcohol test will be utilized for this screen.
 - Dry Run: A flat rate charge when services are not rendered.
2. Delete Vital Signs from fee schedule listed at the end of Paragraph II (Project Specifications). This charge is covered in the Juvenile Clearance.
3. Add Court Charges to the fee schedule listed at the end of Paragraph II (Project Specifications). This is a “flat rate” charge when the contractor is requested to appear in court. Court Charges will be billed to the Solicitor of the Juvenile Court, or other appropriate persons.
4. Add Paragraph XII. Sub-Contractors:

Any person undertaking a part of the work under the terms of the proposal, by virtue of an agreement with the Contractor, must receive approval of the Carroll County Purchasing Manager prior to any undertaking. The County may terminate the proposal if the subcontracting is done without the approval. A listing of personnel shall be forwarded with the Contractor’s proposal.

All other Specifications, Terms and Conditions, not affected by the above changes and additions, remain in effect.

Bidders shall indicate in their proposals they have received this addendum (Addendum 1), MEDICAL SERVICES FOR JUVENILE DETAINEES (Solicitation 10-A003). Proposals without this acknowledgement may be rejected.

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
