

PHASE I ARCHAEOLOGICAL SURVEY

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The Carroll County Board of Commissioners submits Addendum 3 to Solicitation No. 10-A015, **PHASE I ARCHAEOLOGICAL SURVEY**. In an effort to clarify the Specifications, Conditions and Terms the following changes or additions are made to the original Request for Proposal (RFP).

CHANGES AND ADDITIONS TO ORIGINAL SOLICITATION

1. The proposals are due **3:00 PM ET on Wednesday, March 24, 2010**.
2. The following is the clarification to the Scope of Work provided by FEMA and GASHPO:

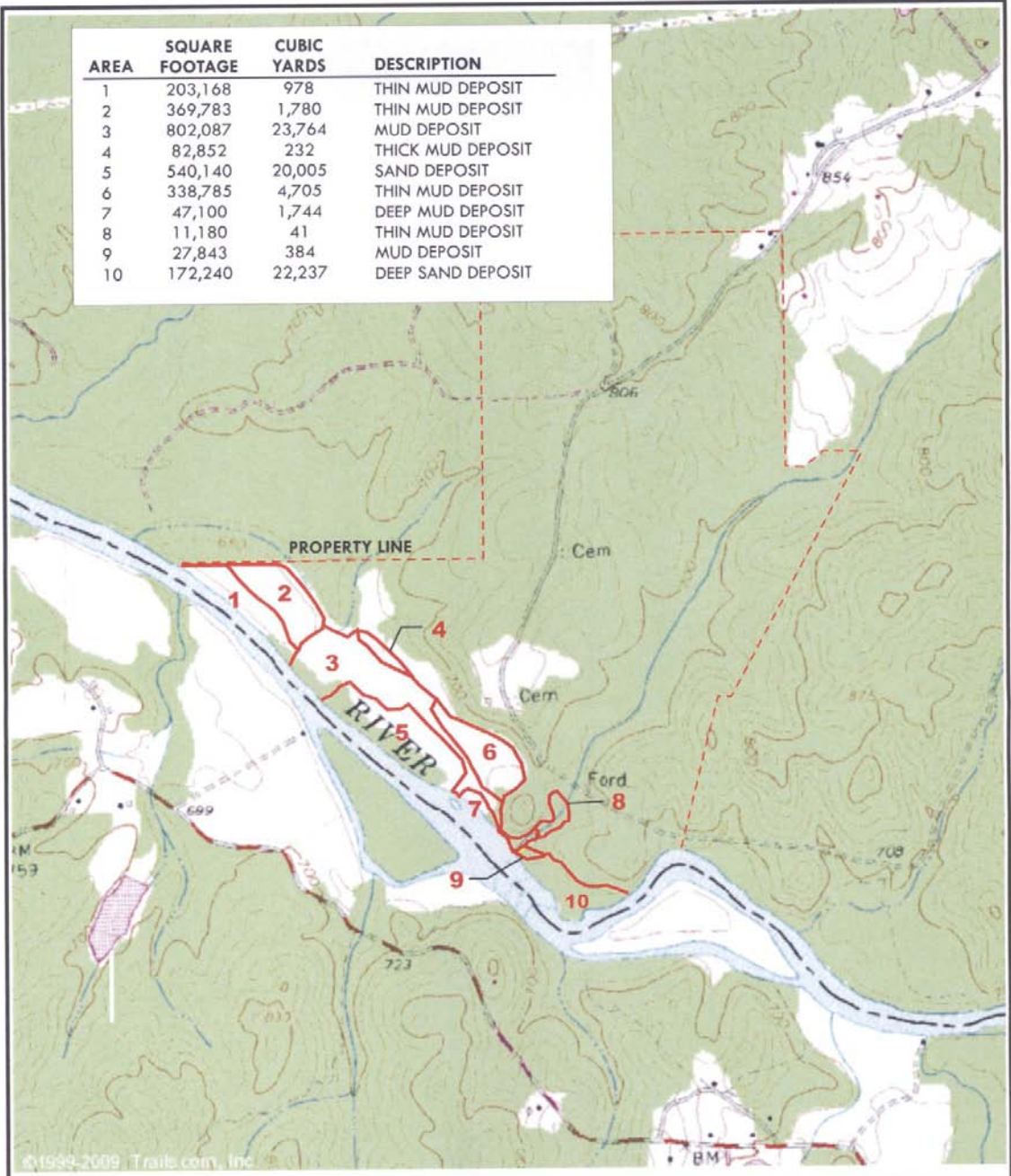
FEMA and the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Historic Preservation Division have recommended a Phase I Archaeological Survey be conducted at McIntosh Reserve Park in Carroll County, Georgia. The Phase I Survey will take place within the 58 acre Area of Potential Effect (A.P.E.). No backhoe work will be required. If during the course of the survey any sites are deemed potentially eligible for National Register Status and FEMA (Lead Agency) agrees with the analysis, prior to agreement of GASHPO, permission is given to proceed to Phase II. The Phase I archaeological survey shall be conducted in accordance with the standards set forth in "Archaeology and Historic Preservation: the Secretary of the Interior's Guidelines", and in "Georgia Standards and Guidelines for Archaeological Surveys" Georgia Council of Professional Archaeologists. The curation of any artifacts, with their supporting documentation, shall be at the A.J. Waring Archaeological Research Lab at the State University of West Georgia. A management summary is required within 5 business days of the completion of field work.
3. The requirement to trench at 20 meter intervals has been deleted. All digging and shovel testing shall be in accordance with the standards listed in paragraph 2.
4. Attachments 1 and 2 are provided to identify the 58 acre A.P.E.
5. Bidders shall provide an hourly rate for any Phase II work which may result.

All other specifications, Terms and Conditions, not affected by the above changes and additions, remain in effect.

Bidders shall indicate in their proposals they have received Addendums 1 through 3. Proposals without this acknowledgement may be rejected.
