

**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CONTRACT WITH
THE PROSECUTING ATTORNEY’S COUNCIL OF GEORGIA
FOR STATE PAID COUNTY REIMBURSED PERSONNEL (SPCR)**

WHEREAS, the District Attorney’s Office for the Coweta Judicial Circuit serves Carroll County, and is jointly funded by appropriations from the State Legislature and Carroll County;

WHEREAS, some, but not all, of the attorneys and clerical and investigative employees of the District Attorney’s Office are funded by the State of Georgia with all of the fringe benefits of State employees, including, medical, dental, and life insurance options, and retirement benefits; and

WHEREAS, it is equitable and desirable by the District Attorney and Carroll County to offer the same benefits package to all similarly situated employees of the District Attorney’s Office;

WHEREAS, OCGA § 15-18-20.1 authorizes counties to contract with the State through DOAS, by way of the Prosecuting Attorney’s Council of Georgia, in order to allow non-state paid District Attorney employees to be processed through the State payroll system, thereby entitling those employees to the same fringe benefits as other State employees;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County approves the attached Contract with the Prosecuting Attorney’s Council of Georgia and authorizes the District Attorney of the Coweta Judicial Circuit to execute the attached Contract, provided that the Contract is substantially in the same form attached hereto as Exhibit “A” and the Contract includes the following provision:

“Carroll County’s obligation for this contract is limited to no more than the amount approved by the County for the District Attorney’s budget pertaining to the services outlined in this agreement. Any additional financial obligations in excess of the amount approved in the county budget will be the sole financial responsibility of the District Attorney and shall be paid from any other non-state appropriated sources of funding available to be used for the payment of personal services.”

The District Attorney shall be responsible for transferring to the State the required funds as necessary for all compensation, benefits, travel, and other expenses for all such personnel.
