Who and Where?

Residents of Carroll County

NO CURFEW IN PLACE



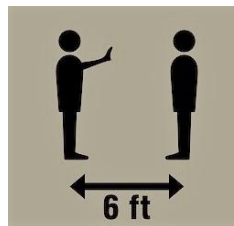
No Gatherings

Of any size, public or private outside of the home



When is this Effective?

Until April 12th at 11:59PM



Social Distance from Others

Stay at least 6 feet away from others even outside

Only Leave To:

- ✓ Get essential items: food, supplies, household items, prescriptions, take-out orders.
- ✓ Seek medical care: seeing a doctor, dentist, getting medical supplies, pet emergencies or needs.
- ✓ Get some fresh air: take a walk with your family, run or bike on the Green Belt or at a county park, play in your yard, walk your dog.

Stay at Home, Do Not

- ⊘ Run non-essential errands for items or services that can wait.
- ⊘ Go to parks or playgrounds, gyms, salons, non-essential trips, others' homes
- ⊘ If sick or at high risk, stay home except to seek medical care.

What's Essential?

Not sure if your employer is considered essential or not? Ask your supervisor or business' owner.

If your employer isn't sure, they can refer to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security determines Essential Business and Infrastructure. This includes but is not limited to grocery stores, convenience stores, gas stations, hardware stores, department stores, building supply stores, hospitals, doctors' offices, public works, first responders, law enforcement, newspapers and media, banks/financial institutions, maintenance services, taxis, legal services, and mail services.
